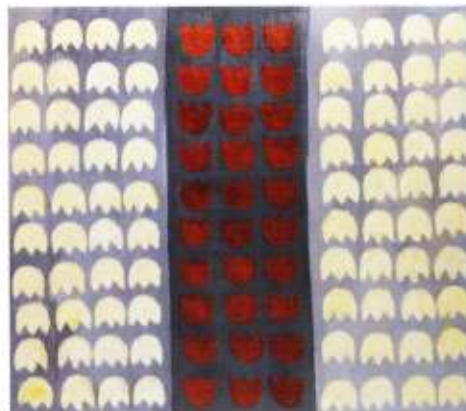

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Agata Drogowska in 1992 graduated the Academy of Fine Art in Poznań.

She received a diploma on Painting and Plastic Arts from prof. Jerzy Kalucki and prof. Alicja Kępińska. In 1999, together with Mirek Kaczmarek and Katarzyna Kujawska, she established the InterCity Association, Young Artists of Different Media. Right now she is the vice president of the Association.

Her fields of work include painting, graphics, urban space arrangement, artistic film.

She is a full-time co-worker of women's magazines and home decorating magazines. She publishes in major Polish magazines: Wysokie Obcasy – an extra with Gazeta Wyborcza, ELLE Decoration, Weranda, Cztery Kąty, Stylowy Dom, Villa, Rezydencje, Ładny Dom and the like.

In the 2002 – 2003 season together with Mirek Kaczmarek she was the artistic director of the „Nation for Itself” gallery in the Polish Theatre in Poznań.

In 2003 she organized the Artistic Benches Action for the 750th anniversary of the settling of Poznań.

After the huge success of the first edition, the Artistic Benches are one of Poznań's attractions since 29th of June 2005.

She is now occupied with actions in the urban space: revitalizing through art and artistic stops.
